Along with our monthly family rides, we often have a sport ride to ensure there is a ride for everyone.

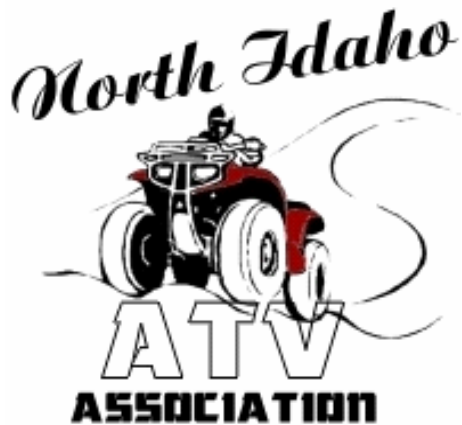
